School Uniform and PE Kit Expectations

At Foxfield Primary School we take great pride in our school community. We believe that a consistent school uniform plays a vital role in promoting our school ethos, providing children with a clear sense of identity and belonging, and setting an appropriate tone for a focused learning environment.

Recently, we have noticed an increasing number of children wearing items that do not align with our uniform policy. In particular, we have noticed a rise in black hooded zip up jumpers and children not wearing the branded school jumper/cardigan or a royal blue jumper/cardigan.

To ensure we maintain our high standards and keep the focus on learning, we would like to take this opportunity to "reset" and remind all families of our uniform expectations:

School Uniform

- Black or Dark grey skirts, or trousers
- White polo shirt with Foxfield Logo
- Royal blue sweatshirt bearing the school logo or royal blue cardigan
- White, black or grey socks or tights
- Plain flat black shoes or plain black trainers (no coloured soles, laces or designs)

PE Kit

- Black shorts or leggings
- White T-shirt
- Pumps or trainers

We have also noticed children wearing hoop earrings or dangling earrings. These are not allowed due to health and safety and children should only be wearing stud earrings.

We also encourage families to make use of our second-hand uniform provision. Please contact the school office if you would like to view our current stock; similarly, if your child has outgrown their uniform, we gratefully accept donations of clean, good-quality items to help support other families.

We ask that all families ensure their children are in the correct uniform from *Monday 23rd February 2026*, the first Monday half term.
