#### **Inclusion Quality Mark (IQM) & Centre of Excellence**

The IQM assessment is a rigorous process that evaluates how well a school includes all its pupils. The assessor spent two days in school living and breathing who we are as a school and what we do each day. We are thrilled to share that the assessor described Foxfield as an *"exceptionally inclusive and highly effective school where inclusion is the defining principle that shapes every aspect of the school's provision"*.
